Developmental Activities:

In every educational institution, infrastructural development is an important aspect that needs to be taken care of. When development vis-a-vis infrastructure takes place, only then the individuals will be able to carry out their duties in an appropriate manner and lead to progression of educational institution. Since the inception of this college, the activities related to development have always been at the forefront and rigorous efforts have been made time and again by both the authorities and the students. It is worthwhile to mention that NAAC team visited the college in 2019 and gave a B+ grade to the college. After that many grants for infrastructure development were provided to the college. An amount of Rs. Two Crore was sanctioned to the college under RUSA which was utilized for up gradation of college infrastructure. Such efforts have resulted in the establishment of certain innovative infrastructure in the college.

SMART CLASS ROOMS: The smart Class rooms is a state of the art facility where students receive elaborate training for improving their learning. Smart classes use all interactive modules like videos and presentations and this visually attractive method of teaching becomes appealing to students who are already struggling with the traditional method of teaching in a classroom. The college has already developed two smart class rooms within the premises where digital teaching learning devices of high quality have been installed. Several classes have already started operating in the smart class rooms. The use of these devices has made the learning process innovative and interesting for teachers as well as students.

LIBRARY AUTOMATION:

The libraries are referred to the places, where there is the availability of various materials, which are meant to acquire information and enhance the understanding of academic concepts among students. Not only the students, but the teachers also make use of library facilities. Taking benefit of modern technology, the college has undergone the process of Library Automation, in which the computers are used to keep track of all the books that are issued, returned and added in the library. The college has a record of 10508 Books till date.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT COURSES:

College has introduced some Skill Development Courses in association with various reputed institutions for benefit of students. The Central University of Jammu (CUJ) in collaboration with the Department of Higher Education, J&K Government started a Soft Skills and Personality development Course to train the interested candidates.

These programmers' started by the CUJ will enable the students to seek admission into various specializations offering challenging job opportunities and career prospects. Another (ITI) Skill course in Computer Concepts (CCC) was started by NIELIT. Dr. Prem Singh is the coordinator of the college to organize the skiil courses in soft skill and computer course concept.




"World Environment Day" (05-06-2020)




"INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA" (21-06-2020)


"Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti" (02 -10-2020)





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
"CONSTITUTION DAY" (26-11-2020)

members along with the honorable Principal of the Government General Zorawar Singh Memorial Degree College, Reasi adopted an oath to celebrate the occasion.




"MATRA BHASHA DIWAS" (21-02-2021)














Govt. General Zorawar Singh Memorial Degree College Reasi (J&K) celebrated International Women's Day on 8th March 2021.




